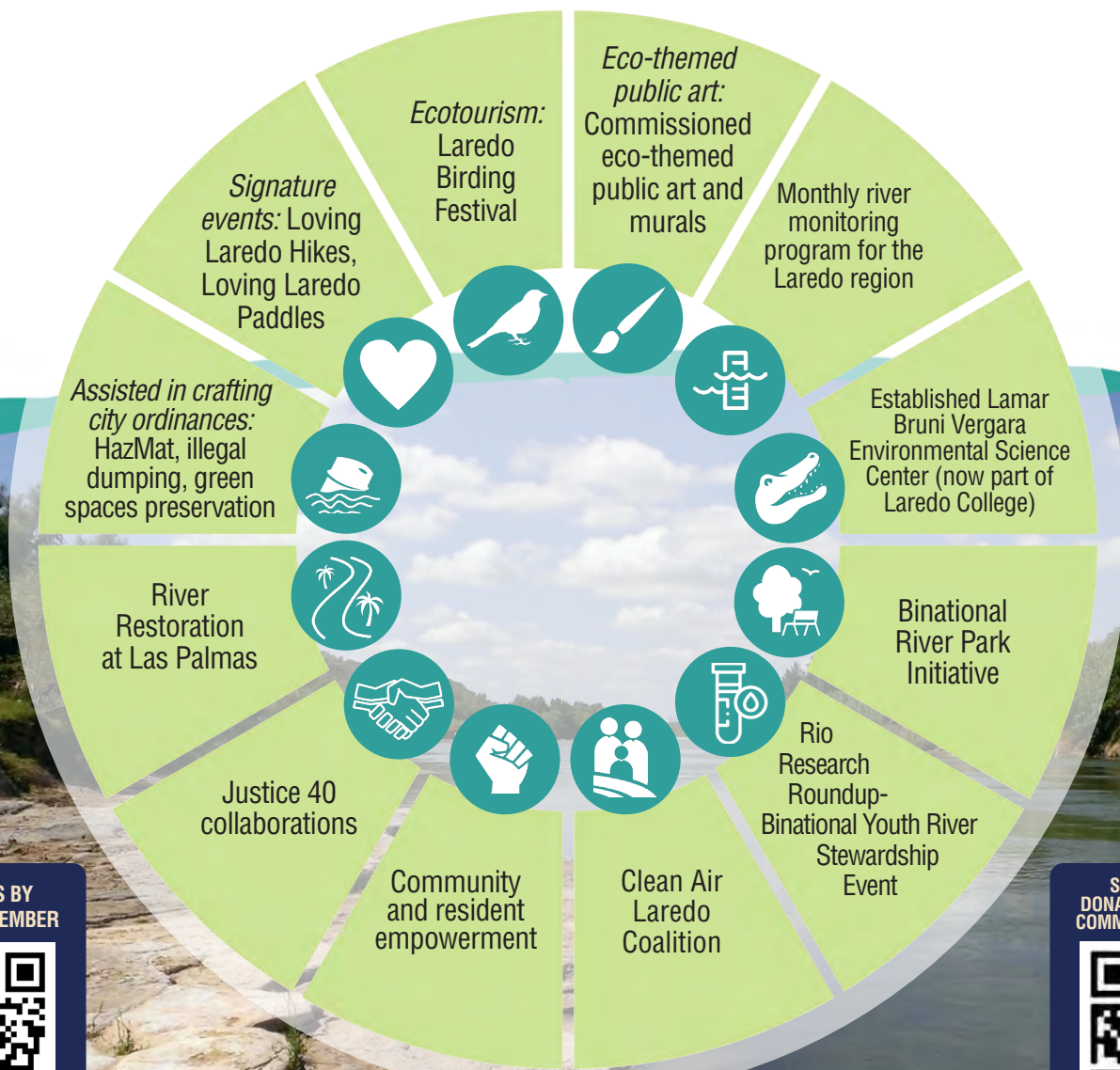


Since our inception in 1994, our mission has been to preserve and protect the Rio Grande-Rio Bravo, its watershed and environment.
